

• If you have not already integrated your Facebook with your TeamRaiser account, simply click on Fundraise on Facebook found on the right-hand side of your Participant Center homepage.




PLEASE NOTE: The Facebook Fundraiser must be created through your TeamRaiser account and not from your Facebook page.


If you create a fundraiser from your Facebook page, the fundraiser will not be linked to your DM fundraising page and the donations will not be reflected there!

Click the 3 dots and choose **Edit Fundraiser** to change the **Title**, **About** text, and **Cover Photo** of your




You can also share your **Personal Page** on any of your social media pages right from the Participant
